Jasper County Emergency Management Commission receives \$1,000 grant for Loss Control Purchases

Jasper County Emergency Management Commission has received a \$1,000 grant from the Iowa Communities Assurance Pool (ICAP), the members property and casualty coverage provider.

The ICAP Grant, a special initiative in celebration of the Pool's 30th Anniversary, provides up to \$1,000 per member for the purchase of select loss control and/or risk management items. Such items include, but are not limited to:

- Approved playground surface materials;
- Exit signage;
- Automated External Defibrillators; and
- Fire extinguishers.

Jasper County Emergency Management Commission submitted an application for the grant in February, and was recently awarded \$1,000 from the Pool. The member used the funds to purchase an AED.
